



Registration Terms and Conditions

Please read the following Registration Terms and Conditions carefully before completing your registration. By registering for the TRA 2026 Conference, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you are registering on behalf of another individual or organization, you confirm that you are authorized to accept these Terms on their behalf.

1. Definitions

- **Organizer** – Magyar Közút Nonprofit Zrt. (address: Hungary, 1024 Budapest, Fényes Elek street 7-13., CRN: 01-10-046265) – refers to the legal entity responsible for the strategic organization and ownership of the Conference.
- **Participant / You** refers to any individual attending the Conference in any capacity, including attendees, speakers, exhibitors, sponsors, or invited guests.
- **Conference** – Transport Research Arena, TRA 2026 Budapest – refers to the event as promoted on the official Conference website, including all associated sessions, exhibitions, and side events.

2. Registration and Payment

- 2.1. Registration is not confirmed until full payment of the applicable registration fee has been received.
- 2.2. All fees must be paid in the currency indicated on the registration platform. Any bank transfer or transaction charges are the responsibility of the Participant and must be paid in full to ensure receipt of the correct amount.
- 2.3. Upon successful payment, an invoice will be sent to the email address provided during registration.
- 2.4. If you are registering on behalf of an organization or another individual, you confirm that you are authorized to do so and that all Participants are aware of and accept these Terms and Conditions.

3. Cancellations, Refunds, and Substitutions

- 3.1. All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to the contact address provided on the Conference website. Refunds will be processed as follows, unless mandatory legal provisions require otherwise:
 - **More than 60 days prior to the Conference:**
90% of the registration fee will be refunded, less a 10% administration fee.
 - **Between 30 and 60 days prior to the Conference:**
50% of the registration fee will be refunded, less a 10% administration fee.
 - **Within 30 days of the Conference:**
No refunds will be issued.
- 3.2. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after the published deadline or for failure to attend the Conference.
- 3.3. Delegate substitutions are permitted at no additional cost, provided that written notice is given prior to the Conference.
- 3.4. Participants are solely responsible for canceling any travel or accommodation arrangements. The Organizer accept no liability for such costs.

4. Conference Program and Changes

- 4.1. The Organizer reserves the right to modify the Conference program, speakers, content, format, schedule, or venue at any time.
- 4.2. Program changes do not constitute grounds for a refund or compensation.
- 4.3. Opinions expressed by speakers, exhibitors, or sponsors are their own and do not necessarily reflect the views of the Organizer.

5. Conduct and Access

- 5.1. Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner at all times.
- 5.2. The Organizer reserves the right, without refund, to refuse admission to or remove any Participant whose behavior is deemed disruptive, inappropriate, or contrary to the purpose of the Conference.
- 5.3. Badges are personal and non-transferable. Misuse of badges or unauthorized solicitation is prohibited.

6. Liability and Insurance

- 6.1. Attendance at the Conference is at the Participant's own risk. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Organizer, professional conference organizer, venue operators, and service providers shall not be liable for any personal injury, loss, damage, or theft of property.
- 6.2. The total liability of the Organizer in connection with the Conference shall not exceed the amount of the registration fee paid by the Participant.
- 6.3. Participants are strongly advised to arrange appropriate travel, medical, and personal insurance coverage.

7. Data Protection and Privacy

- 7.1. By registering, Participants consent to the collection, processing, and storage of their personal data for the purpose of organizing and delivering the Conference, in accordance with applicable data protection laws, including the GDPR.
- 7.2. Personal data may be shared with trusted service providers involved in Conference delivery, strictly for operational purposes.
- 7.3. Participants have the right to access, correct, or request deletion of their personal data by contacting the Organizer.

8. Photography and Recording

- 8.1. The Conference may be photographed and recorded. By attending, Participants grant the Organizer the right to use images and recordings in which they may appear for promotional and communication purposes related to the Conference.

9. Force Majeure

- 9.1. The Organizer shall not be liable for any delay, modification, or cancellation of the Conference due to events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, acts of terrorism, pandemics, government restrictions, or venue unavailability.

10. Assignment and Subcontracting

10.1. The Organizer reserves the right to subcontract or delegate aspects of the Conference organization and delivery to third parties, including professional conference organizers and service providers.

10.2. Participants may not assign or transfer their registration without prior written consent from the Organizer.

11. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws applicable to the Conference location. Any disputes arising in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of that jurisdiction.

12. Amendments

The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Updated versions will be published on the Conference website and will take effect immediately upon publication.
